At the same time, we're helping to level the playing field by connecting talent to opportunity, tackling inequalities and promoting social justice.







CHANGEMAKER STUDIOS

Unloc was founded in 2013 by award winning young leaders Hayden Taylor and Ben Dowling, in response to funding for their local youth forum being cut. Devastated by the loss of the youth forum, the duo decided that something needed to change, and that we needed to build changemaking into the heart of education and find new ways to help connect young people to purpose.

Aged 16 and 19 respectively, Hayden and Ben setup Unloc as a non-profit that truly believes every young person can be a changemaker. They convinced their local college to convert an old storage cupboard into an HQ, and got to work building new game changing education programmes, designed to build young people's agency and confidence, connect them to purpose, and equip them with the skills to thrive.

Fast forward to today, Unloc programmes have already reached and supported over 100,000 young people since the organisation's founding.
